

## **PFF activities eligible for Professional Development**

**Category 3B. Create and implement professional development workshops for new, continuing, and part-time personnel.**

Preparation and delivery of PFF workshops and presentations (topics might include "Settling Grievances," "Know Your Rights," "Surviving the Tenure Process").

**Category 3E. Become informed about, and act on, changing regulations, legislation, and state programs which affect the College.**

Time spent on PFF and/or COPE (Committee on Political Education) activities such as reviewing current statewide initiatives and informing constituents of possible impact to the community college system and our teaching profession.

**Category 3F. Participate in community college business at the state level. This includes the state Academic Senate and other community college associations and commissions.**

Participation in local and statewide union meetings and activities, such as the CFT annual convention, the CFT Community College Council meetings, and the San Diego -- Imperial Valley Labor Council meetings.

**Category 3I. Gain the knowledge needed for effective service in the rotating positions of Faculty Senate President, Department Chair, Professional Development Coordinator, and Tenure and Evaluation Coordinator.**

Participation in CFT/AFT training workshops such as programs for grievance officers, negotiation team members, and e-board members. Attendance at CFT Union Leadership Institute (ULI) would apply to this category.
